ABAC Sigma Alpha Swine ShowdownRules and Regulations

- 1. Show officials reserve the right to interpret all rules, and their decisions will be final. After pigs have been weighed and leave the scales, there will be no changes made. Any changes that need to be made must be made before leaving check-in. Show officials also reserve the right to reject any entries for whatever reasons necessary. **Decisions made by show officials will be final**.
- 2. All entries must be accompanied by **current health papers** at the time of check-in.
- 3. Exhibitors from all states will be eligible to show.
- 4. Any exhibitor ages 4 through 21 (as of September 6th, 2019) will be allowed to enter the show. Pre-club exhibitors must be able to exhibit his/her hog without the assistance of an adult or older exhibitor in the ring.

 A.Showmanship will be divided into the following divisions:

i. Novice: ages 4-8ii. Junior: ages 9-12

iii. Intermediate: ages 13-17

iv. Senior: ages 18-21

- 5. There is no limit for the number of entries per exhibitor, but only one showmanship entry will be allowed per exhibitor.
- 6. Clipping animals on the premises will not be allowed.
- 7. Due to the limited amount of pens available, they will be first come first serve. There will be not additional pen charges. You may show out of your trailer if you wish.
- 8. All hogs must be tagged, and tag numbers must be included on the entry form. Each tag must be clean and readable at the time of check-in. State-issued tags are not necessary. **No hogs will be accepted without a tag.**
- 9. All purebred gilts and purebred barrows must have registration papers.
 - A. The breakdown for breed divisions for the breeding gilt show will be as follows: Yorkshire, Hampshire, Duroc, All Other Breeds (AOB). Show officials reserve the right to change this based on the number of entries.
 - B. Each class will be broken down by Gilts/Barrows birthdate.
- 10. Gilts and Barrows entered in the market show will be eligible for the purebred gilt/barrow show, but an extra \$10 per hog will be charged.
- 11. All entries must be postmarked by September 1st 2019. Late entries will be charged an additional \$15 per showman for entries received from September 2nd until the day of the show. **ALL ENTRIES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.**
