Exhibitors are responsible for reading and adhering to the rules.

Failure to adhere to any rules shall result in the disqualification of the entry and exhibitor.

- Show is open to exhibitor's 12th grade and under from any state
- Showmanship divisions will be Senior (11th-12th), Junior (9th-10th) Intermediate (7th-8th), Novice (4th-6th), Peewee (3rd grade and under)
- Health papers are required for all swine
- No limit on number of entries you can show
- A Substitute driver is allowed if you have more than 1pigs in a class. Exhibitor must use their own animal in showmanship or be disqualified.
- **Weighing and weigh back:** Exhibitors will be required to turn in weigh cards declaring weight of each entry. Official scales will be located in barn and exhibitors will be responsible for weighing and turning in cards for their entries. If an exhibitor wins a class or is 2nd place, they will be reweighed and must be within 5% of the weight on card. If exhibitor weighs out, the 3rd place animal will be moved up and weighed, this will continue until two exhibitors have weighed within 5% (+ or -) of recorded weight. Once an exhibitor's entry has been reweighed in class there will be no further weigh backs for that entry. Any issue regarding the scales or the weighing process must be brought to the show officials prior to check-in ending, after that time no issues regarding the weighing process will be addressed.
- All animals must have a readable ear tag.
- Show will include:
 - **Registered Breeding Gilts-** born after 6/1/18. Must present registration papers day of show and papers must be in exhibitor's name. Registered gilts will be shown by weight in mixed class.
 - **Barrows & Gilts-** will be show separately for market classes' 280lb limit
- Double entries are allowed if you pay for both entries.
- Entry fee is \$30 per animal, \$10 for showmanship
- Due to size of barn pens are 1st come 1st serve. Exhibitors may show off trailers if desired or when pens are full.
- Heat lamps will not be permitted to stay on overnight in barn.
- No refunds will be given
- Entry deadline is 1/4/2019(**this is not postmark date they must be received by deadline date. Late entries will be accepted at double the cost and must pay cash day of show**)

- Concessions will be available
